Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made and executed on this 28th day of October 2025 and shall be in effect from 01st November 2025 ("Effective Date") by and between

ELifecycle Management Private Limited, a company incorporated under the provisions of Companies Act, 2013, having its registered office at Flat No. 502, 5th Floor, Siri Sampada Arcade III, Khajaguda, Gachibowli, Hyderabad, Telangana-500089, India (hereinafter referred to as "Elima," which expression shall, unless repugnant to or inconsistent with the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns), of the First Part.

AND

Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad, registered under the Society Registration Act, 1860, vide Registration No. 67 of 1957-58 (hereinafter called "Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE)" which expression shall, unless repugnant to or inconsistent





with the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns), of the Other Part.

Elima and Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad shall hereinafter be individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Elima is an authorised E-waste recycler dedicated to promoting circular economy principles by providing innovative recommerce and recycling solutions for efficient product, resource, and waste management services to businesses and institutions.

WHEREAS, Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad desires to collaborate with Elima to implement comprehensive sustainability solutions on its premises, including knowledge sharing and expert lectures on e-waste management and recycling, conducting awareness sessions and collection drives, facilitating training programs, offering probable internship and project opportunities, establishing an ELifecycle Management Club, and ensuring responsible collection, segregation, and disposal of e-waste through Elima's expertise and network.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants hereinafter set forth, the Parties agree as follows:

1. SCOPE OF MOU

- Elima shall provide comprehensive sustainability solutions to MRCE; focusing on knowledge sharing and expert lectures on e-waste management and recycling.
- Elima commits to conducting two (2) awareness sessions annually for students and staff to promote responsible segregation and collection of recyclable materials.
- Elima will organize two (2) collection drives per year at MRCE for effective recovery of recyclables, supported by detailed logistical planning.
- Elima shall facilitate training programs for MRCE students on sustainable waste management.
- Elima may offer internship and project opportunities related to waste recycling and sustainability for MRCE students wherever deemed fit by Elima.
- Elima will plan and the Parties shall collaborate on joint initiatives to promote environmental responsibility and green campus practices.

- Elima permits MRCE to establish an ELifecycle Management Club at MRCE to engage students
 actively in sustainability projects, awareness campaigns, and practical initiatives related to e-waste
 and circular economy principles.
- Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad shall exclusively engage Elima for the disposal and recycling of all e-waste generated from its premises and it's affiliated institutions. Any deviation shall be considered material breach and shall be considered as a valid ground for termination of this MoU by Elima.
- Minimum assured quantity required for scheduling pick-up

Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad agrees to provide Elima with all reasonable and necessary access permits, including gate passes and security clearances, to ensure uninterrupted access for waste collection and associated manpower deployment.

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that all services rendered by ELIMA to Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) under this MOU are provided on a voluntary and non-remunerative basis. These services are offered by Elima solely for the purpose of promoting education, environmental awareness, and accountability, and shall not be construed as commercial or profit-driven in nature. No financial consideration, fee, or other form of compensation shall be payable by either Party in connection with the





activities contemplated herein, and nothing in this MoU shall create any obligation of payment, employment, partnership, or agency between the Parties.

2. INDEMNITY AND LIABILITY

- i. Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad shall bear sole responsibility for the safe and secure collection, storage, and segregation of recyclable materials on its premises, adhering strictly to guidelines laid out by Elima.
- ii. Both Parties mutually agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the other Party, its affiliates, officers, employees, and agents against all claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including legal fees) arising from any breach, negligence, or wilful misconduct related to the performance of this MOU.
- iii. Elima shall not be liable for any damage, loss, injury, or claim arising out of improper segregation, storage, or handling of waste by Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad or violation of laws by Malla Reddy College of Engineering (MRCE) Hyderabad.

3. TERM AND EXTENSION

This MoU shall become effective from the date of signing and shall continue for a period of Two (02) years unless earlier terminated in accordance with Clause 4 ("TERM"). Extension of the Term shall require written agreement signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

4. TERMINATION

- i. This MoU shall automatically terminate on the expiration of the Term or on completion of the project unless extended by mutual written consent.
- ii. Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing a minimum of thirty (30) days of prior written notice to the other Party.
- Party may terminate the MOU with immediate effect upon written notice, subject to a reasonable cure period of fifteen (15) days if rectifiable.
- iv. Upon termination, all outstanding obligations shall survive and remain binding.





5. CONFIDENTIALITY

The Parties agree to treat all non-public information exchanged in connection with this MOU as confidential and shall not disclose it to any third party without prior written consent, except as required by law or for enforcement of this MOU.

6. AMENDMENTS

Any amendments, modifications, or waivers of terms under this MOU shall be effective only if in writing and duly signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

7. NOTICES

All notices, requests, consents, and other communications shall be in writing and delivered to the addresses of respective Parties as set forth above or such other address as may be designated in writing.

8. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- i. The Parties shall endeavor to resolve amicably any dispute arising from or related to this MOU through good faith negotiations.
- ii. Failing amicable resolution, disputes shall be referred to senior management representatives of each Party for resolution within thirty (30) days.
- iii. If unresolved, the Parties agree to submit the dispute to binding arbitration conducted in Hyderabad, Telangana, India under the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, with a sole arbitrator appointed by mutual agreement.

9. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the Laws of India. The courts of Hyderabad, Telangana shall have exclusive jurisdiction over all disputes relating to this MoU.

10. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither Party shall be liable to the other or be held to be in breach of this Agreement for failure to carry out all or any obligations under this Agreement, as a result of Force Majeure which expression shall include all circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Party in question, including but not limited to acts of God, acts of war, acts of government, fire, explosions, natural calamities, outbreak of epidemic, pandemic,





sabotage, civil commotion, riots or any other event not in control of the Parties provided that the respective Party uses its best efforts to carry out its obligations reasonably required in the circumstances.

In the event the Force Majeure event sustains beyond 30 days, both the Parties shall mutually discuss further course of action.

11. SURVIVAL

Clauses relating to Indemnity, Confidentiality, Dispute Resolution, Governing Law, and Jurisdiction shall survive termination or expiry of this MOU.
