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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into on this 5th day of January 2026 by and between Dr. B.R.K.R. Government Ayurvedic Medical College, A Government Institution under the department of AYUSH, Government of Telangana, located at Egra gadda, Hyderabad, Telangana, and represented by its Principal, (herein after referred to as "First Party", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns);

AND

MALLA REDDY COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING (MRCE), Sponsored by Chandramma Education Society, approved by AICTE, Affiliated to Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad (JNTUH), recognized under Section 2(f) & 12(B) of the UGC Act, ISO 9001:2015 Certified Institution, located at Maisammaguda, Dhulapally, Secunderabad – 500100, Telangana, and represented by its Principal, Dr. M. Ashok, (herein after referred to as "Second Party", which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigns).

The First Party and the Second Party are hereinafter collectively referred to as “**the Parties**” and individually as “**a Party**.”

PREAMBLE

Whereas **Dr. B.R.K.R. Government Ayurvedic Medical College** is a premier institution dedicated to education, research, and clinical practice in Ayurveda and traditional Indian medicine systems, contributing to holistic healthcare and societal well-being;

Whereas **Malla Reddy College of Engineering** is committed to excellence in technical education, research, innovation, and community engagement, with a strong focus on sustainable development and interdisciplinary learning;

Whereas both institutions recognize the importance of **integrating traditional knowledge systems with modern engineering and technological solutions** to address contemporary societal challenges and achieve the **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**;

Now, therefore, the Parties hereby enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to establish a framework for academic, research, innovation, and outreach collaboration.

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MoU

The objectives of this MoU are to:

2. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

The collaboration under this MoU may include, but is not limited to, the following activities:

1. **Joint Research Projects**
 - Technology-enabled Ayurvedic healthcare solutions
 - Herbal drug standardization, automation, and quality analysis
 - Biomedical instrumentation and health informatics
2. **Academic and Training Programs**
 - Guest lectures, workshops, seminars, and FDPs
 - Short-term certification programs for students and faculty
3. **Student Engagement and Internships**
 - Engineering student internships in Ayurvedic research, hospitals, and laboratories
 - Collaborative student projects addressing real-world healthcare challenges

4. Innovation and SDG-Based Initiatives

- Development of sustainable medical devices and wellness technologies
- Joint participation in National Science Day, health camps, and outreach activities

5. Community Outreach

- Health awareness programs using technology
- Sustainable and affordable healthcare solutions for society

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE FIRST PARTY

(Dr. B.R.K.R. Government Ayurvedic Medical College)

The First Party agrees to:

1. Provide academic and clinical expertise in Ayurveda and traditional medicine.
2. Facilitate access to laboratories, hospitals, and research facilities, subject to institutional policies.
3. Nominate a faculty coordinator to oversee collaborative activities.
4. Participate in joint academic, research, and outreach programs.
5. Support joint publications, patents, and project outcomes wherever applicable.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SECOND PARTY

(Malla Reddy College of Engineering) The Second Party agrees to:

1. Provide technical expertise, laboratories, and infrastructure support for collaborative activities.
2. Nominate a faculty coordinator to coordinate with the First Party.
3. Encourage student participation in interdisciplinary projects and internships.
4. Support innovation, prototyping, and technology development aligned with Ayurveda and SDGs.
5. Organize joint programs, seminars, and outreach initiatives.

5. COORDINATION AND GOVERNANCE

- Each Party shall appoint one **MoU Coordinator** for effective implementation.
- Periodic review meetings shall be conducted to assess progress and plan future activities.
- All activities shall be carried out with mutual consultation and written consent.

6. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- This MoU does not involve any financial commitment by default.
- Any financial implications for specific activities shall be decided separately through mutual agreement.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- Intellectual Property arising out of joint activities shall be shared as per mutually agreed terms, documented separately for each project.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality of all shared academic, technical, and research information unless disclosure is required by law or mutually agreed upon in writing.

9. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **three (3) years** from the date of signing.
- It may be extended by mutual written consent.
- Either Party may terminate the MoU by giving **three months' written notice** to the other Party.

10. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- This MoU is a statement of intent and does not create any legal or financial obligations.
- Any amendments shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties.
- Disputes, if any, shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussion.
