 - Premium: Only ₹22 per year.
 - Eligibility: Available to individuals aged 18–70 years with a bank account.
 - Ease of Enrollment: Simple registration through banks or online platforms.
- 4. Q&A session: An interactive question-and-answer session followed the presentation, allowing participants to clarify doubts and gain a deeper understanding of the scheme. Questions ranged from eligibility criteria to claim procedures, and the representatives provided comprehensive answers.
- 5. Vote of Thanks: The program concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Yashwanth, expressing gratitude to Dr. M. Ashok, the NSS team, Manohar Trust, and all attendees for making the event a success.

Feedback and Suggestions


Participants appreciated the clarity of the presentation and the relevance of the topic. Some suggestions for future events included:
