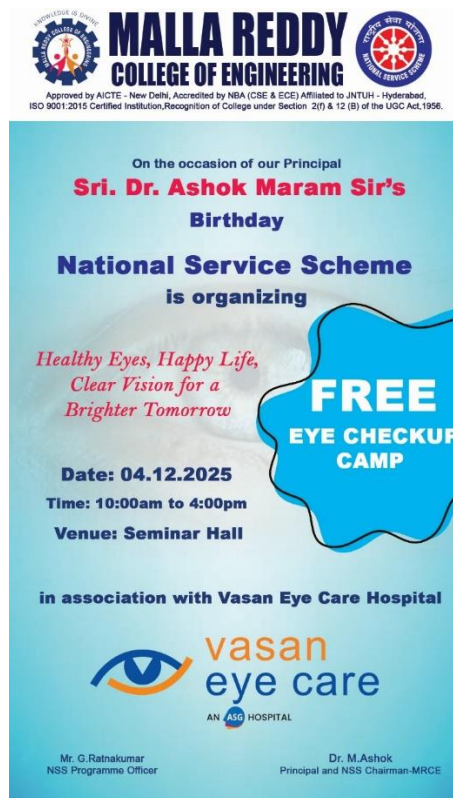

Core Services

- **Comprehensive Vision Screening:** Professional optometrists provided free consultations and eye health assessments.
- **Clinical Enrollment:** Detailed documentation was maintained, capturing participant names, roll numbers, and departments (specifically highlighting high engagement from branches like CSE-AM and CAM).

Specialized Awareness: Glaucoma Prevention

A major focus of the two-day event was educating the public on **Glaucoma**, often referred to as the "silent thief of sight".

Key Educational Points Shared:

- **Nature of Disease:** Damage to the optic nerve typically caused by high eye pressure.

- **Variants Explained:** Volunteers explained the difference between slow-developing **Open-angle glaucoma** and sudden **Angle-closure glaucoma**.
- **Early Intervention:** Emphasis was placed on regular screenings, as early detection is the only way to prevent permanent vision loss.

- Recognition under **UGC Act 1956**.














Conclusion
