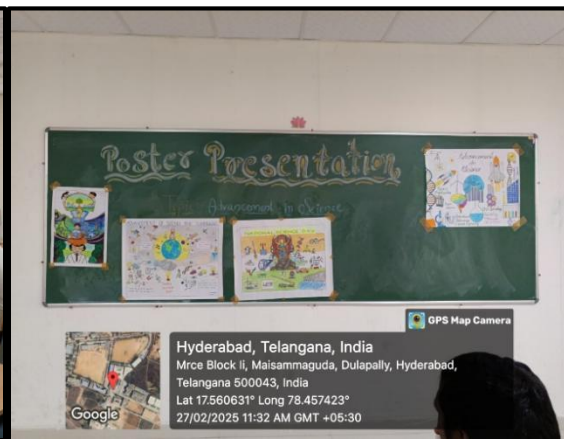
Day 1: 27th February 2025

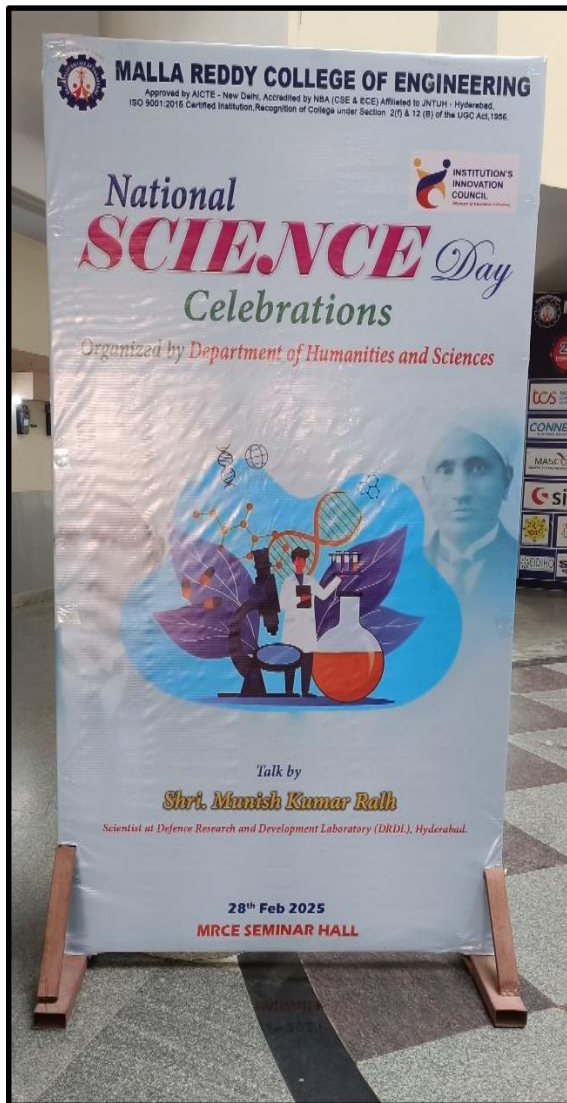

Mumbai and later joined DRDL as a Scientist 'B' in 2005. His expertise includes aerodynamic design of flight vehicles, CFD analysis, missile configuration studies, and drag reduction techniques. He has contributed to several research projects, publishing 9 technical papers and 30 technical reports. He is also a member of the Aeronautical Society of India and the Astronautical Society of India.
