Objectives of the Program

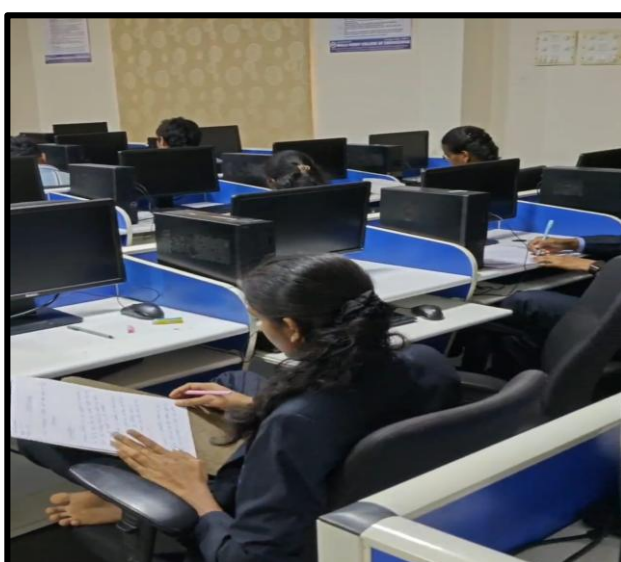
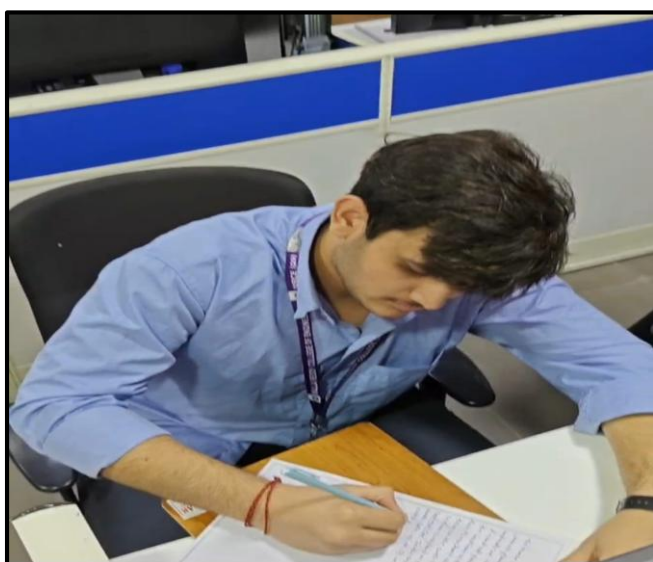
- To create awareness about the causes, effects, and prevention of environmental pollution.
