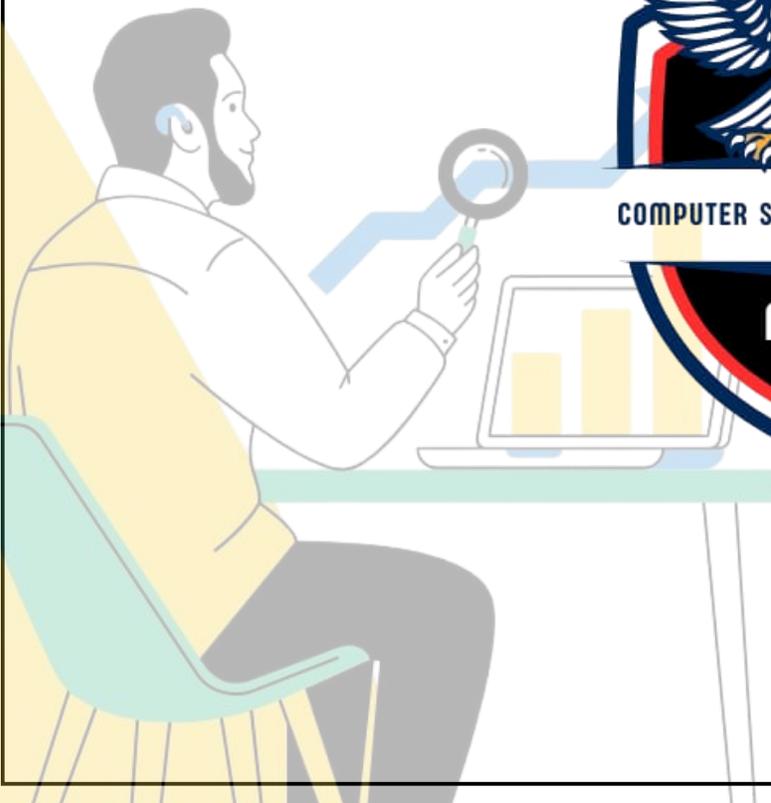

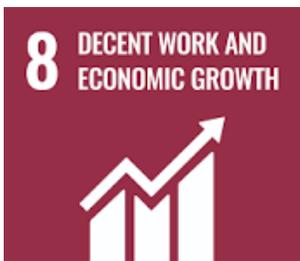
SDG GOALS
