Report on Engineers Day Celebrations - 2025

In India, Engineer's Day is celebrated on 15th September of every year to commemorates the birth anniversary of Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya and recognise the contribution of engineers in the development of the nation and remind all the engineers of the country. In 1968, the Government of India decided to observe September 15 as National Engineers Day.

Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya was born on September 15, 1861 in Karnataka. He studied Bachelor of Arts from the University of Madras later he completed a diploma in civil engineering at the College of Science in Pune. The creation of 'block systems' is attributed to Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. He patented and installed an irrigation system with water floodgates at a reservoir near Pune to raise the water supply level and storage. This irrigation system which was installed at the Khadakvasla Reservoir near Pune, was later installed at Tigras Dam at Gwalior and Krishnaraja Sagara Reservoir, KRS Dam in Mysuru.

He was awarded 'Bharat Ratna' for his exceptional contribution to the building of India in 1955, became a member of the London Institution of Civil Engineers before he was awarded a fellowship by the Indian Institute of Science (IISC) Bangalore. He has also conferred the British knighthood and served as Diwan of Mysore from 1912 to 1918.
