

## Report on

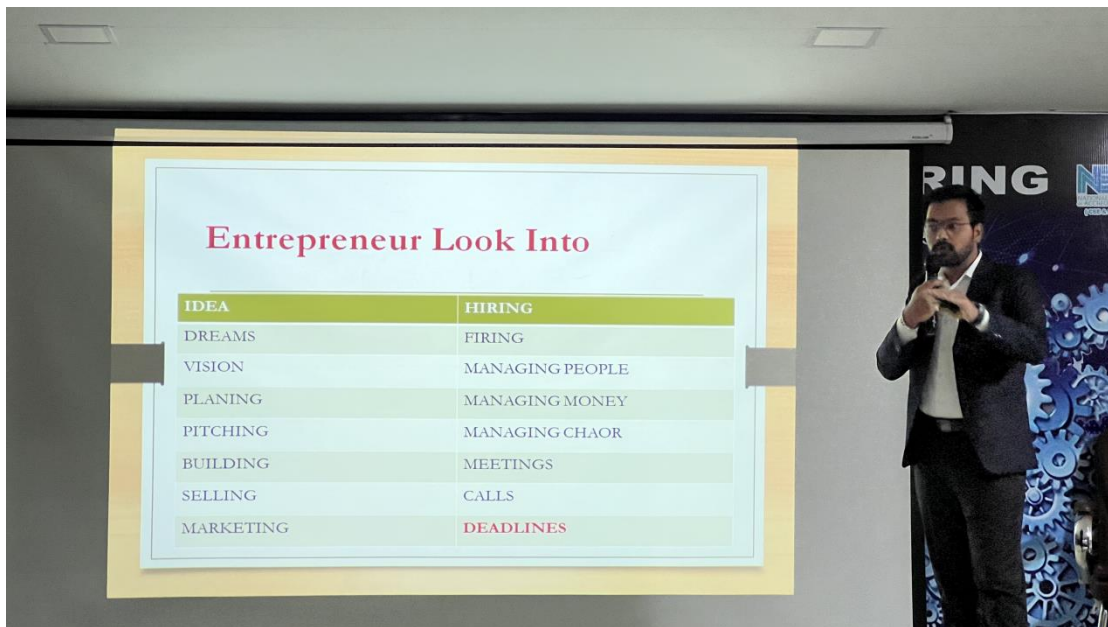
The EDC aims to conduct many such initiatives to empower students and nurture a strong startup ecosystem within the campus.

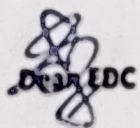
