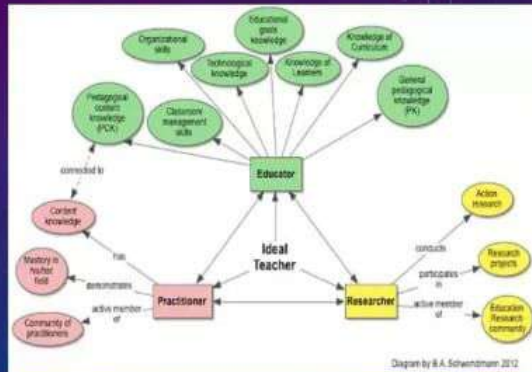

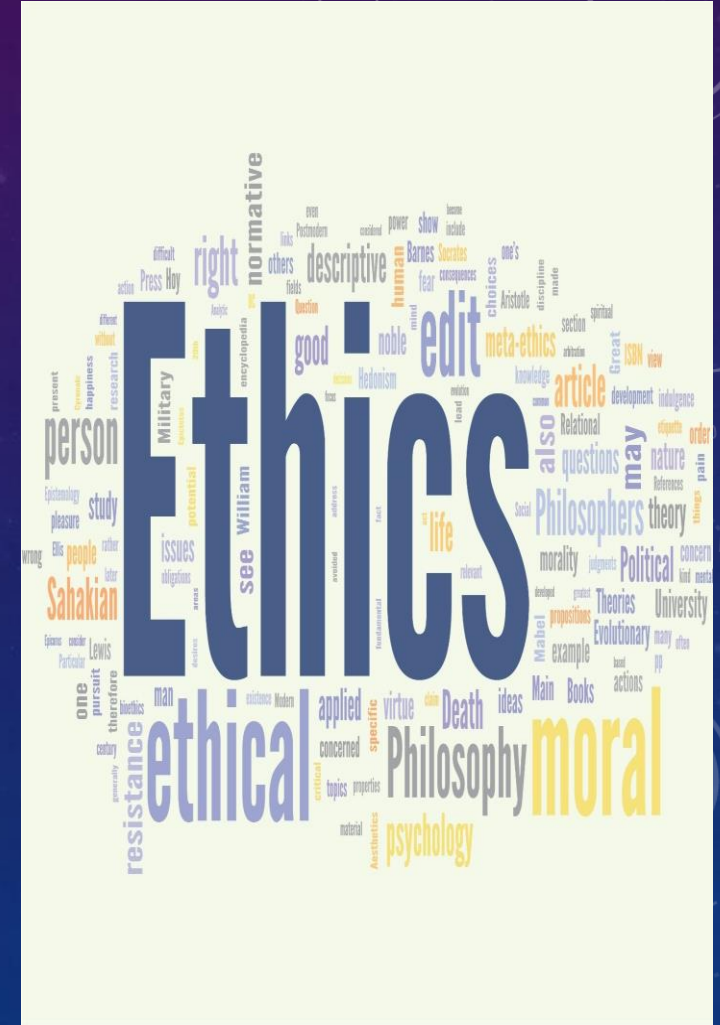

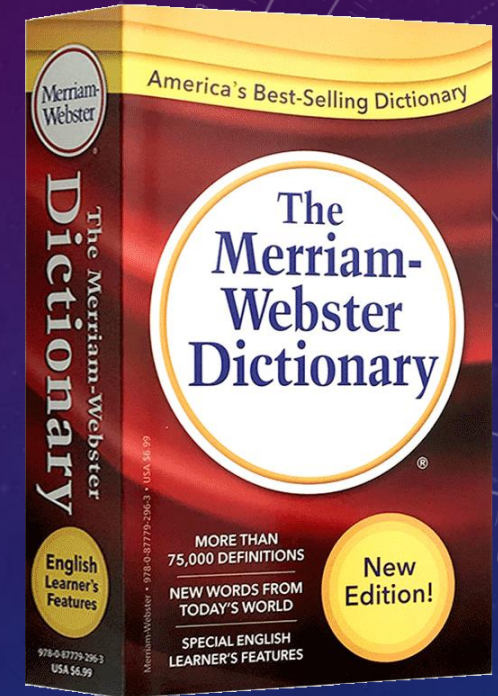
- The word 'Ethics' is derived from the Greek word "Ethos" = Character and Latin word "Mores" = Customs.

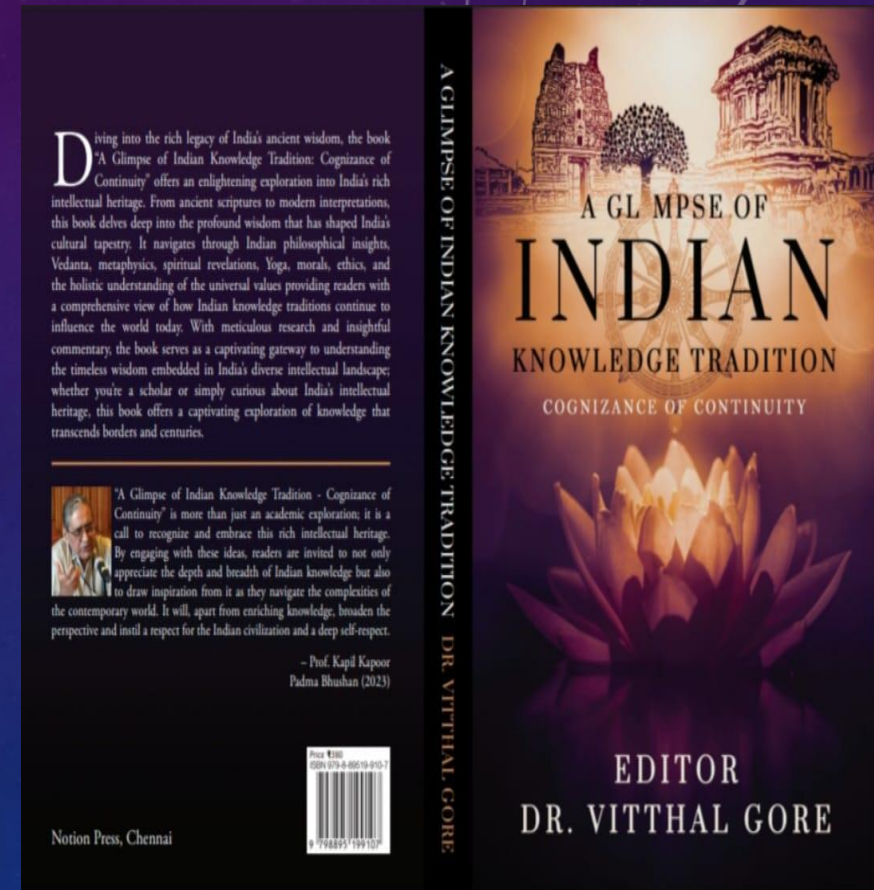

- The field of ethics, along with aesthetics, concerns matters of value; these fields comprise the branch of philosophy called axiology.



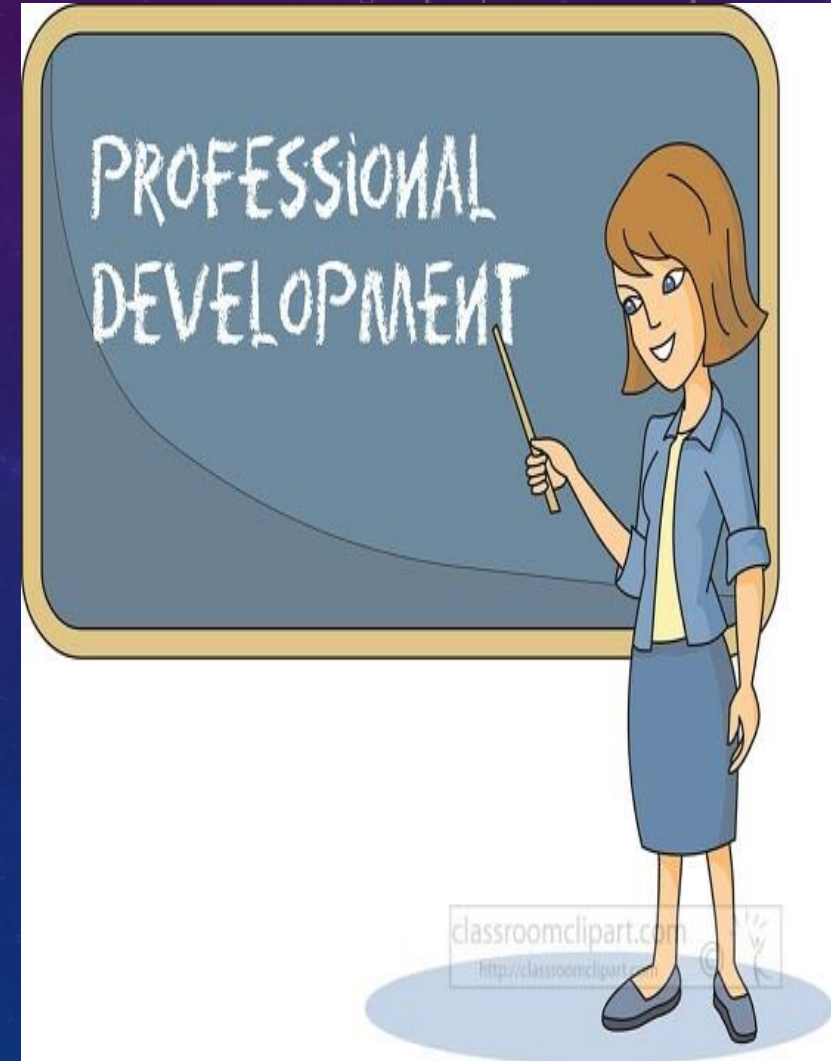
DEFINITION OF PROFESSIONAL ETHICS

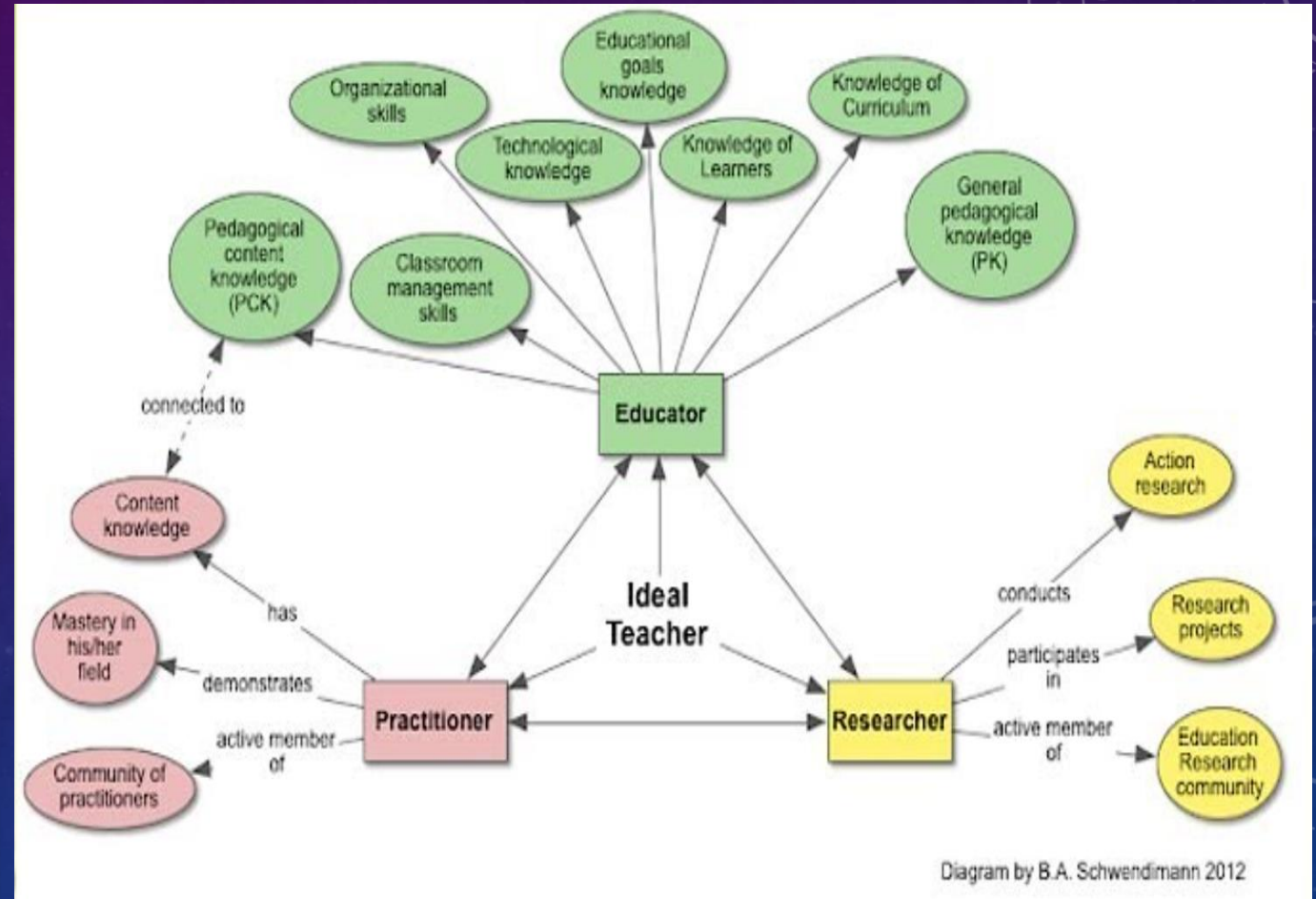

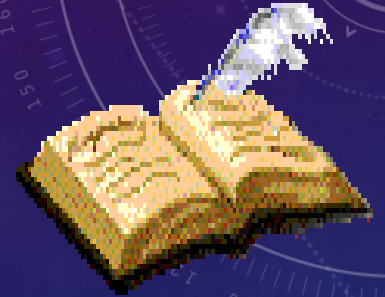

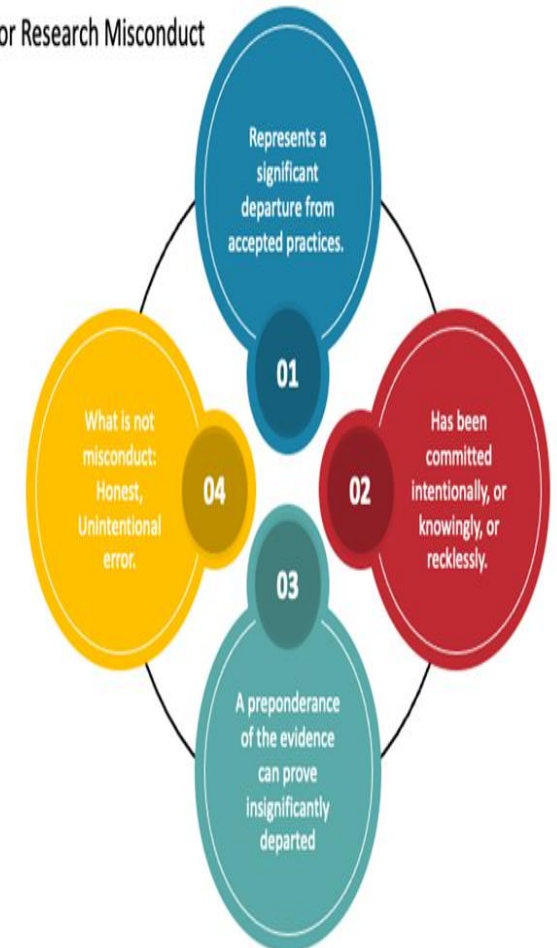
FABRICATION, FALSIFICATION AND PLAGIARISM

- **Fabrication** is “making up data or results.”
- **Falsification** means **manipulating research materials, equipment, or processes**, or changing or omitting data or results such as the research is not accurately represented in the research record.
- **Plagiarism** is **presenting someone else's work or ideas as your own**, with or without their consent, by incorporating it into your work without full acknowledgement.

Plagiarism may be intentional or unintentional but it is unethical and the violation of Intellectual Property Rights

Criteria for Research Misconduct

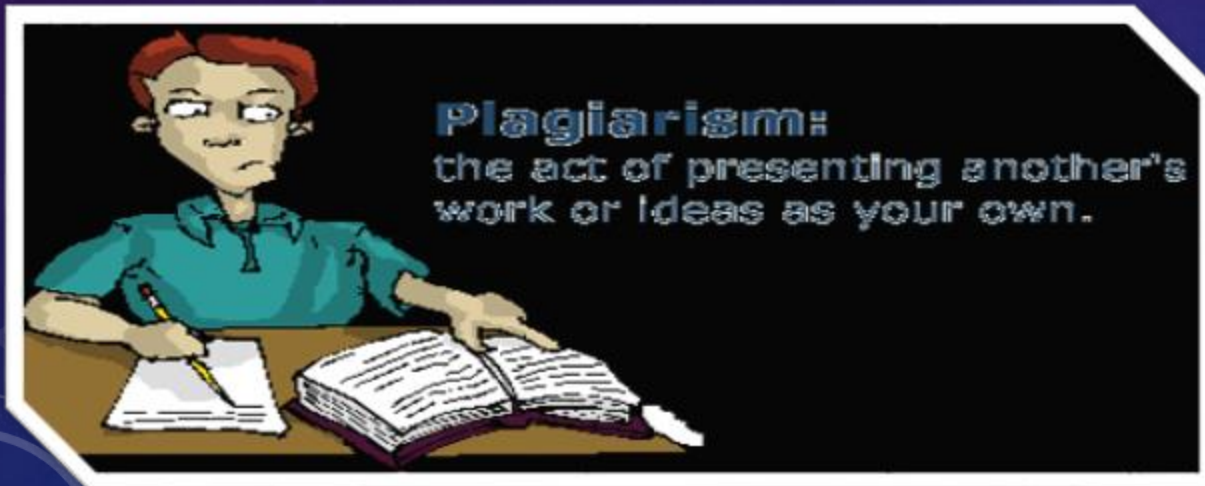

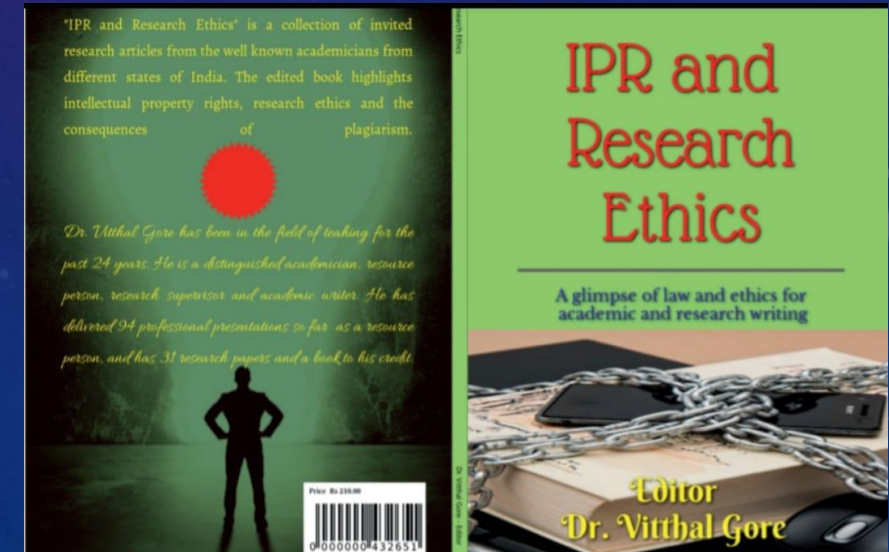
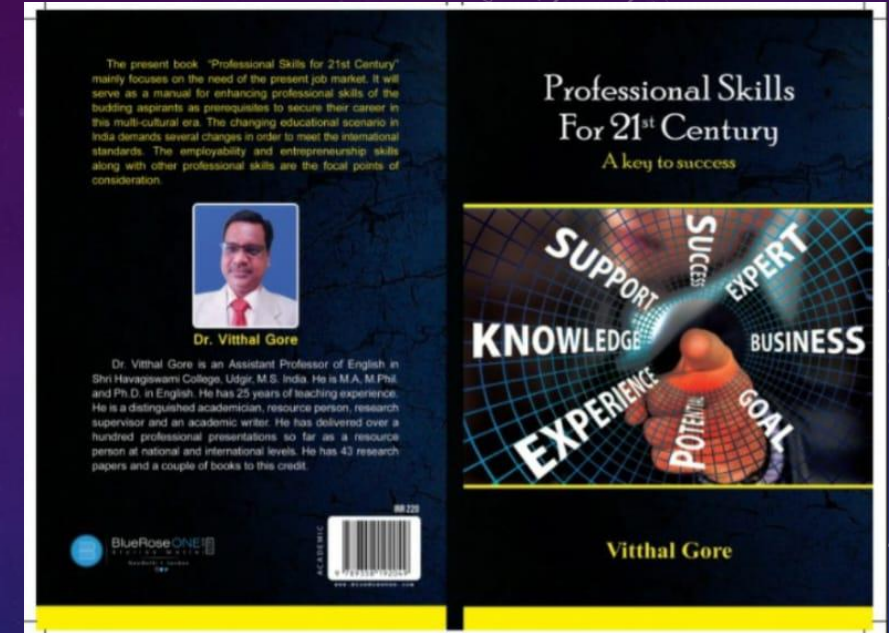
