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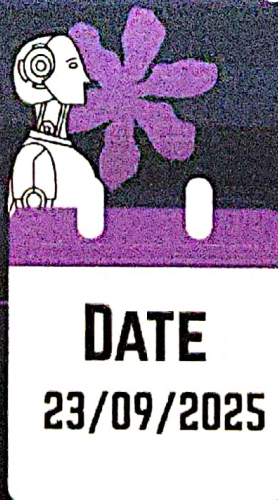

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1. Introduction

The **Women Empowerment Cell** at MRCIE, in collaboration with Nirmaan Organization Under CSR Initiative AI Skills Passport Program, successfully conducted one-day on 23.09.2025.

1. AI Skills Passport (AISP) by EY + Microsoft

- A free online 10-hour learning program for ages 16+, to teach fundamentals of AI, ethical aspects, applications in business, tech, sustainability, etc. [EY + I](#)
- Participants receive a co-branded EY/Microsoft certificate and access to additional learning/employment resources. [EY + I](#)
- The goal is to help equip young people (especially from underserved populations) with AI skills to be employable in an AI-driven economy. [EY](#).

Nirmaan Organization

NGO working in India (founded 2005), focusing on Education, Skill Development, Entrepreneurship, etc

They have multiple existing programs: Youth Skill Development (IT, Communication, Life Skills), placement assistance, CSR partnerships.

They have “Microsoft & Nirmaan Organization Free Online Training & Placements” program under their “Nirmaan Skills Ready” which offers free training & placement in tech / soft skills etc.

2.Objectives of the AI Skills Passport Workshop

1. Raise Awareness About Artificial Intelligence (AI)

- Introduce participants to basic AI concepts: what AI is, how it works, and where it's used.
- Demystify AI to reduce fear and misinformation, especially among first-time tech learners.

2. Build Foundational AI Literacy

- Help learners understand the types of AI, data-driven decision-making, and machine learning basics.
- Enable students to distinguish between AI myths and facts.

3. Promote Ethical Use of AI

- Introduce ethical considerations in AI (bias, privacy, transparency).
- Encourage responsible AI usage and digital citizenship.

4. Provide Hands-On Exposure to AI Tools and Applications

- Demonstrate real-world applications of AI across domains: healthcare, education, agriculture, etc.
- Offer interactive activities (e.g., chatbots, AI art, sentiment analysis) to make learning engaging.

5. Enhance Career Readiness and Employability

- Expose participants to AI-related career pathways, job roles, and industry demand.
- Guide students on how AI skills can be integrated into various job sectors (not just tech).
- Offer resume tips, interview prep, and LinkedIn profile setup if applicable.

6. Deliver an EY–Microsoft Certified Learning Experience

- Enable participants to complete the 10-hour AI Skills Passport online course (or begin it).
- Ensure they qualify for and receive the co-branded certification from EY & Microsoft.

7. Encourage Lifelong Learning in Digital Skills

- Inspire learners to pursue further upskilling opportunities in AI, coding, or digital literacy.
- Promote platforms for continued learning (LinkedIn Learning, Coursera, Future Skills Prime, etc.)

8. Bridge the Digital Divide

- Provide access to digital infrastructure and mentoring to underserved youth.

- Empower students from low-income or rural backgrounds to enter the AI-driven future.

9. Strengthen CSR Impact and Community Engagement

- Demonstrate the company's social responsibility commitment through skill-based volunteerism.
- Create measurable social impact (e.g., number of learners certified, skill upliftment, placement rates).

3. Inaugural Ceremony

The Inaugural ceremony of AI Skills Passport Program was held with great enthusiasm and participation on September 23rd, 2025 at MRCE-Seminar Hall. The event marked the beginning of an enriching journey aimed at equipping young minds with essential skills for their personal and professional growth.

1. Ready AI Passport (Global AI Learning Community)

A “passport” scheme by Ready AI that tracks learner progression through AI concepts, awards “stamps” or badges for different levels (Citizen, Diplomatic, Special). It includes supports like workshops, teaching support, and a global passport guide.

2. AI Passport for Biomedical Research

A program oriented to upskilling biomedical/clinical researchers in AI: fundamentals, ethics, data sets, image analysis, generative AI, design & communication of experiments.

Emphasis is on minimal prior coding background, with community calls, case notebooks, etc.

“AI Passport” as a cryptographic model passport tool

An open-source project that issues cryptographic “passports” for machine learning models, allowing tamper-proof attribution of outputs to model versions. [GitHub](#)

It provides commands like create-passport, attribute-content, verify-attribution, and uses ONNX, EZKL, etc. [GitHub](#)

AI Skills Passport Program Schedule that you can use for planning and delivering the program as a **workshop or short-term training** — especially when collaborating under a CSR initiative with Nirmaan or similar NGOs.

This schedule is based on the **EY + Microsoft AI Skills Passport curriculum**, which typically takes around **10 hours** to complete. You can run this over 1–5 days, depending on your mode (intensive workshop, weekly classes, blended, etc.).

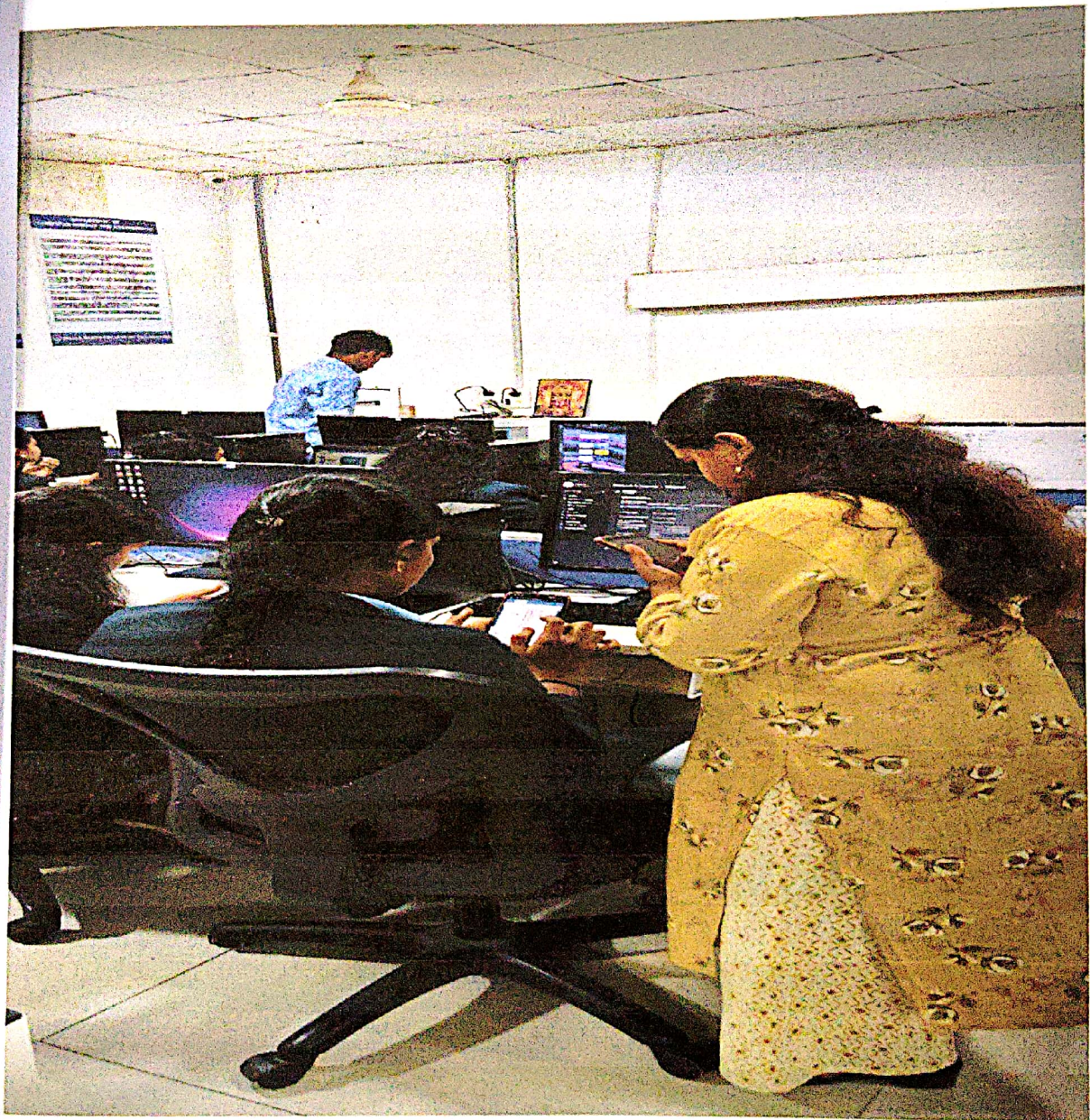
