- The **cultural impact of the Telugu language** and its literary richness.

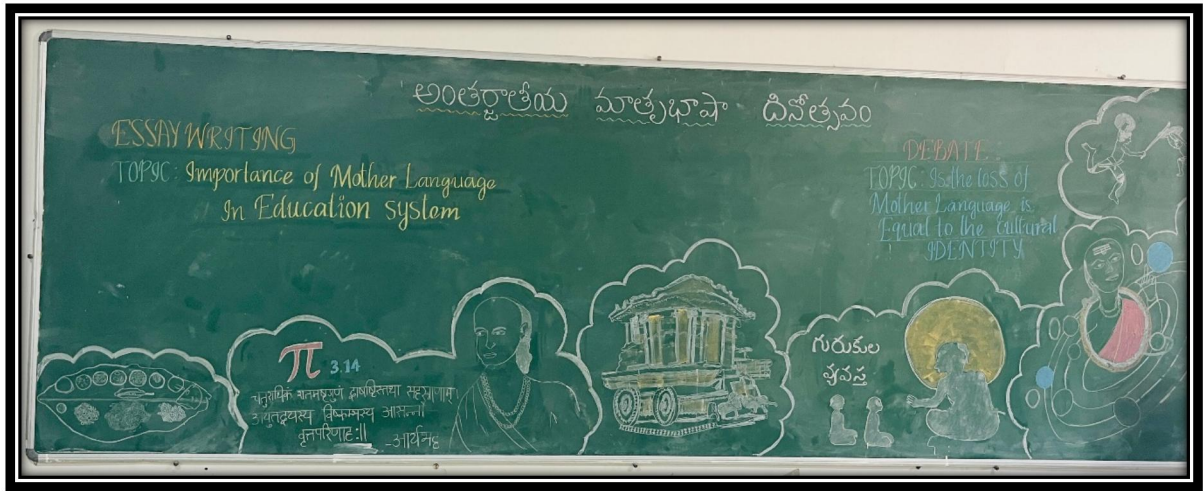
2.2 Pre-Event Competitions

These competitions provided students with a platform to showcase their **creativity, critical thinking, and linguistic pride**.

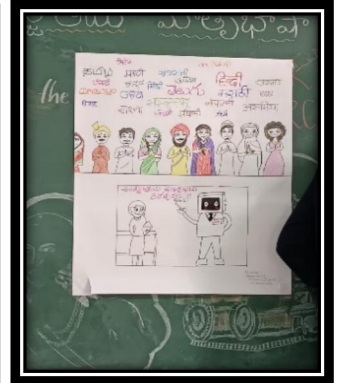
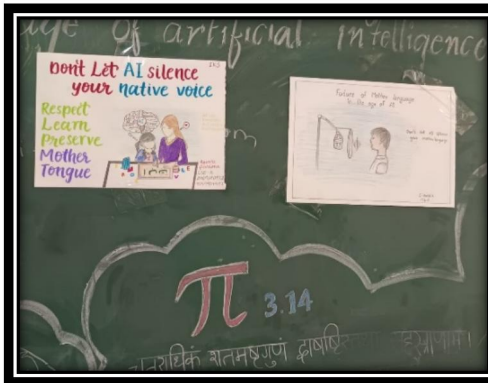

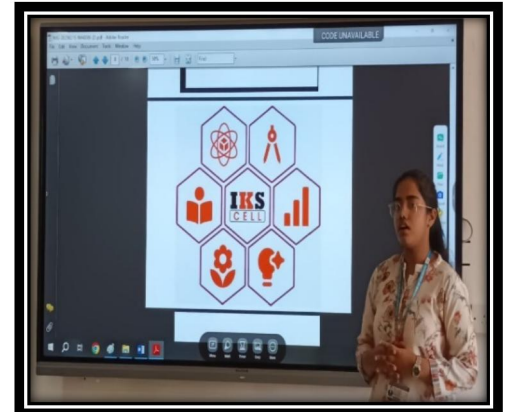
Debate Competition
