These activities created awareness about conservation, healthy habits, and environmental protection.

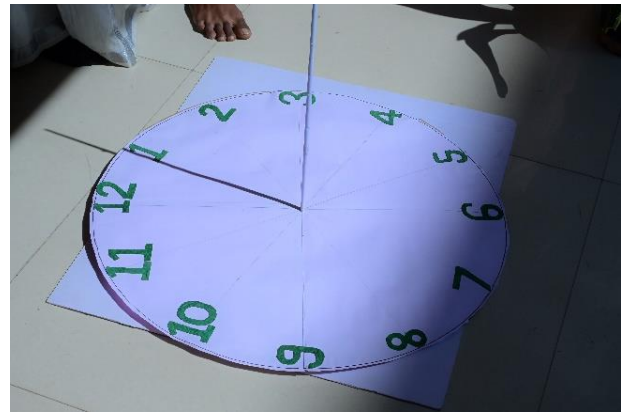

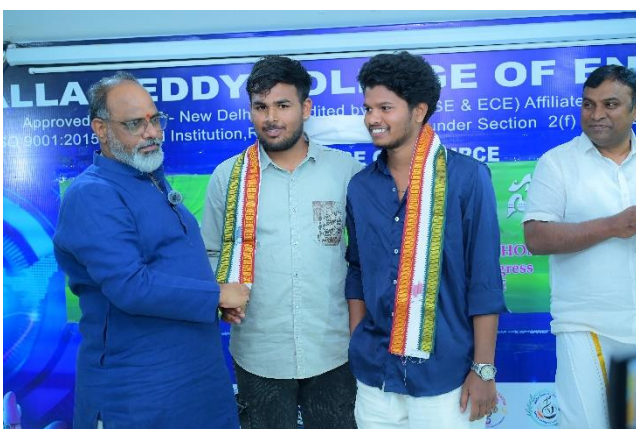


Zone-4: "Root to Innovation: Acknowledging Every Contribution to Growth"
